What Is “All-on-X” and How Can It Transform Your Smile?

If you are missing a full arch of teeth—or facing the loss of your remaining teeth—you may have heard the term **All-on-X**. It’s one of the most advanced solutions in modern dentistry, but what does it actually mean?

The “X” in All-on-X stands for a variable number—typically 4, 5, or 6. Essentially, this procedure allows us to replace an entire upper or lower set of teeth using just a few strategically placed dental implants.

How It Works: Instead of placing an implant for every single missing tooth (which would be costly and invasive), we place a select few titanium posts into the jawbone. These posts act as secure anchors. A custom-made, permanent set of beautiful, functional teeth is then locked directly onto those implants.

Why Dr. Chris Recommends All-on-X:

- **Immediate Stability:** Unlike removable dentures, All-on-X teeth do not slip, click, or require messy adhesives. They function just like natural teeth.
- **Bone Health:** The implants stimulate the jawbone, preventing the facial collapse and bone loss that typically happens with tooth loss.
- **A New Smile Fast:** In many cases, patients can walk out of our office with a temporary, beautiful set of functional teeth the very same day as their procedure.
